Dear Mr Gurney,

We write regarding your email to the BBC of 8 September 2017 which states:

Why, then, is the doc/directory missing?

This regards your request for information under the Freedom of Information Act ("the FOIA") on 1 August 2017 for the Barley source code. The BBC has supplied you with all the information it holds on the Barley source code in correspondence dated 8 September. The BBC has, therefore, fulfilled its obligation under section 1(1) of the FOIA to provide 'any person making a request for information to a public authority;

- (a) To be informed in writing by the public authority whether it holds information of the description specified in the request, and
- (b) If that is the case to have that information communicated to him.'
