Special Educational Needs

As a part of the School's policy of treating all boys as individuals there is a recognition that some boys may experience difficulties as a result of academic, emotional, behavioural or medical problems. The School's Assessment and Pastoral procedures are designed to identify, address and monitor such difficulties in keeping with the DfES Code of Practice. Parents are encouraged to discuss their concerns with the boy's Head of House and they will be consulted appropriately. Full details of the policy and practice are available for inspection at the school. The Individual Learning Needs department offers specialist support to pupils and parents, including those with disabilities. The school takes every possible step to ensure that such pupils are not disadvantaged.

Our SEN provision received positive recognition in the February 2007 Ofsted Inspection. Our SEN policy is reviewed annually by the Governing Body and amended as necessary.
