Hi — thanks for calling. In response to your questions:


- 1. You have been added to the TLS reporting system DistList.
- 2. Alarms: Following recent visit by HSE, we decided to install a new alarm system. We chose a 2-tier system, where an intermittent alert says something has been spotted. People should be on alert and first-aiders on-site should report to the main office for instruction. People should not muster or cease operations. A continuous alarm indicates an emergency situation and all those at site should muster.

This system is included in our induction for every person working at or visiting our site and alarm buttons around the site are clearly labelled.

I'm attaching an extract from our induction package which is delivered face-to-face for every visitor or person working at site.

As always we are happy to discuss if this can be further improved.
