Alarm Signals
Intermittent every 8 Seconds.
Notification of an incident.
Continuous Alarm.
Full site muster required.

 If the continuous alarm sounds then you should immediately evacuate site making your way calmly to the Primary Muster point – unless any other instruction is given – i.e. proceed to secondary muster point.



- Alarm Signals
  - Intermittent every 8 Seconds.
    - Notification of an incident.
  - Continuous Alarm.
    - Full site muster required.



- If you identify an incident then you should press the Intermittent Alarm button.
- The Field response team will then assess the situation and either:
  - Evacuate the site this will be done by pressing the Muster Alarm
  - Stand Down the emergency this will be communicated by Radio and or Megaphone.
- If you hear the intermittent alarm then you should make your work area safe, and await further instructions.



- Possible Reasons for Muster or Evacuation
  - Escape of Gas
  - Fire
  - Protestor Activity
  - Sudden Change of Weather Conditions / Unsuitable Conditions

 The alarms are tested on a random basis, therefore, should you hear any alarm, you should assume it is real, and follow the instructions of the incident commander accordingly
