### **Freedom of Information Act 2000**

Thank you for your emailed request received 16 May 2013, asking for the following information under the Freedom Of Information Act 2000:

- a) addresses of any empty buildings (be it commercial or residential or industrial or industrial or storage facility etc) which belongs to yourselves
- b) addresses of any buildings (be it commercial or residential or industrial or storage or medical facility) which belongs to yourselves, that are scheduled to be vacant in the next 12 months for whatever reason.
- c) if possible, type of use (eg. storage, office, warehouse, training, staff accommodation, medical facility etc) of those buildings referred to in (a) and (b)
- d) if possible, approximate date (month and year) from which it became empty or will become empty, of those buildings referred to in (a) and (b)

The Food Standard Agency does not hold the information you have requested. The FSA does not own any buildings which are empty, scheduled to become vacant or any sites it currently occupies.

If you are not satisfied with the way the Agency has handled your request for information, you should write within two calendar months of the date of this letter to the Openness Team, and ask for an internal review.
