I would like all classified greenbelt and brownfield land as well as residential and commercial property types.

## Responses

South Gloucestershire Council does not have a list of empty/unused land within District. However, it does prepare a number of specific publications annually that contain reference to existing "land use", some of which may be empty/unused. Land uses such as: "former office building", "former garages".

These publications include: the "Residential Land Survey"; the Employment Land Survey"; and the "Brownfield Land Register".
