We have considered your request and in accordance with S.1 (1) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA) can confirm that we hold the information you have requested.

Under section 17 of FOIA, an organisation can have a reasonable extension of time to consider a public interest test; this extension is usually no more than 20 working days. NHS Digital considers it necessary to apply an extension of 20 working days to this request to consider the public interest test. You can therefore expect to receive a response to your enquiry on or before 3rd August 2021.
