Thank you for your Freedom of Information (FoI) request received on 27 November 2014. You asked:

What is the level of benefit for a family of three with an under 5 year old? i.e. the amount the government says they need to live on

The government does not set specific benefit levels for each claimant and their family but rather the level of each benefit, which is reviewed annually and set out in:

The level of benefit that a person can be awarded depends upon their individual circumstances and can only be properly determined when a claim is made.
