The Council deactivated the previous permit management software system on 05 September 2017 in anticipation of a new software system coming into operation in July 2018. The permits are currently managed on a spreadsheet system. Only basic data relating to current permits is maintained.

A charge of £20.00 for the second and additional Resident Permits was introduced in 2011. Prior to this all the Resident Permits were free of charge.

How much revenue did the council receive through local resident parking permit over the past calendar year – 1st January 2017 – 31st December 2017

Information is not available.

All the income from parking permits, on-street and off-street, is received in the same fund stream as the income from suspensions and dispensations. This can not be broken down into income from parking permits only.

The total income generated from parking permits, dispensation notices and suspension of parking facilities in the period 1st January 2017 – 31st December 2017 was £75,650.00.
