

Request:

I would like to know what questions were asked of Uber when they applied for an operators license in North Tyneside and what their replies were, if any, to each question.

For clarity, I do not wish to know any answers that may jeopardize the internal working model of Uber as a business or its technology, (although the actual questions I would like to see) but questions raised for example but not exclusive to how their working practice conforms with legislation and local conditions.

Response:
