Dear Stephen,

At Council yesterday you asked Ralph to provide details on how much the PwC review had cost to inform the forthcoming discussions around Local Government Review in Hertfordshire.

I can confirm that in November 2019, I (Director of Resources) commissioned PwC to undertake an initial piece of work to provide an independent analysis on the potential benefits that structural reform in Hertfordshire could bring by considering a range of options. The cost of this work was £42,000. I have a general consultancy budget that has funded this work in its entirety and all required processes for approval were followed.
