Can I get the breakdown of the following:

1. The top five worst streets year on year

Cannon Lane is the street where the most incidents occur.

2. The average cost to clear these incidents year on year

An estimated clearance charge is £60.

3. How many convictions have been made year on year

None

4. What was the worst incident and how much did it cost to clear away

There was one incident of builder's rubble in the area which had a clearance costing of £260.
