## Review Procedure

If you are dissatisfied with the way in which I have dealt with your request, you are entitled to require a review of this decision. Should you decide to request a review you must:

Apply for a review of our decision in writing within 40 working days of the date of this notice and include:

- An address for further correspondence
- A description of the original request and
- The reason(s) why you are dissatisfied with our decision.

The requests for a review would be passed to another manager who was not involved in the original decision to assess the application.

Following the review you would receive notice of the result as soon as possible but in any case within 20 with the ability to extend it by another 40 working days of us receiving it. Please note the new timescale relates to *the Coronavirus (Scotland) Bill (SP Bill 66) as introduced in the Scottish Parliament on 31 March 2020* Our response would explain the decision of the reviewer as well as details of how to appeal to the Office of the Scottish Information Commissioner if you remain dissatisfied with the review decision reached by us.
