Thankyou for your recent response concerning the phosphoric acid leak. I would like to query one part of the request which stated "The soil was removed and disposed of through a licensed

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contractor. We are unable to confirm the weight and disposal site for the soil as we do not have historic records beyond ten years." Given that this incident took place in April 2002, this is clearly not "beyond ten years." Could you therefore confirm why you would not have the relevant information concerning the weight and disposal of the contaminated soil given that it is within the time period of ten years?
