Please note that you asked in an earlier request of 20 August 2010, reference number RFI20101130, for the following:

a copy of the most recent monthly performance pack provided by Capita to the BBC

You may be unaware that these two titles apply to just the one document. However, because your two requests are actually for the same document, I must explain to you that the BBC is refusing to comply with your new request under section 14(2) of the Act on the basis that we have previously responded to you on this issue.

I understand that your earlier request is currently being considered under our internal review process and that should you expect to receive a reply no later than 7 October.

Should you wish to make another Freedom of Information request about a different document or topic we will of course be happy to consider it.
