Thank you for your Freedom of Information request dated 02 July 2012. In that request, you asked (in relation to your previous request Ref VTF 2370):

For 'Mandatory Work Activity' there are 24 documents amounting to 10.2 megabytes.

For 'Support for the Very Long Term Unemployed' (previously known as Community Action Programme) there are 12 documents amounting to 2.71 megabytes.

For 'Work Programme' there are 140 documents and 5 power point documents amounting to 100.711 megabytes.

Your correspondence also provided three website addresses to which we could upload the information requested previously. We are sorry if our previous responses lacked clarity; the address we need from you is a postal address to which we can send the requested information in CD format.

Our obligation is to send out the information to an address provided where reasonable to do so. We are not obliged to upload information onto file sharing sites, nor is it a requirement for the Department to sign-up as a member of 'What Do They Know' and upload the information direct.

Our offer to provide the information requested in CD format still stands; upon receipt of the information it is for you to choose which websites you upload it to.
