Today, is the moment to pay tribute to each and every one of you. Today, is the moment to honour the Mighty Ark's legacy.

Every one of you should be proud – very proud – of what you stand for. Proud of all that you have achieved.

For the Ship's Company has – together with her embarked Air Squadrons and Royal Marine Commandos – delivered: across the globe, day and night, time and again, over the last quarter of a century.

Your success has been due in part to the remarkable design of this fine Ship. But it owes much more to the people who have both supported her from ashore and served with her at sea.

The Ship's impressive operational record stands testament to your courage, commitment and resourcefulness, both as individuals and collectively and those that came before you. I give my thanks to all of you: those of every Arm, every Branch, and every Trade.

My thanks also go to your families and friends who have supported you throughout your endeavours and to those who have so generously supported this ship throughout its time.

More widely, I am ever grateful for the close links that have developed over the years between the Ship and her extended family, in particular the links with the Cities of Portsmouth and Leeds.

HMS ARK ROYAL has, since her commissioning 25 years ago, loyally served the Crown: deterring conflict, defending the United Kingdom's interests, helping defeat our enemies during conflicts in the Balkans and Iraq, as well as developing diplomatic relations worldwide.
