Re-location of Scarborough Borough Council Offices to Prospect House, Seamer

In considering the proposed re-location the legal advice provided by Gavin Collett, QC needs to be taken into account and references will be made in this response to paras in his Advice (A) and Addendum Advice (AA).

In responding we are mindful that pre-application advice will be confidential at this stage, but would point out that once an application is submitted ERYC would release pre-application advice, and as this advice perforce refers to legal advice it will open up the question of whether that advice also has to be released.
