Thank you for your Freedom of Information request dated 26 January 2014.

In your request, you asked us:-

Please let me know for each of the last four calendar years:

a. How many potholes were repaired on Stroud Green Road (including repairs carried out on behalf of Haringey Council as part of the boundary agreement for maintaining this road). For the potholes, please include both temporary patch repairs and more comprehensive repairs.

Response a:

2010: 34 2011: 45 2012: 38 2013: 43

b. How many times more general resurfacing work was carried out. For the more general resurfacing work, please let me know which stretches of the road were covered.

Response b: Throughout the same period there were five more general resurfacing works carried out, as follows:-

2010: Junction with Morris Place 2010: Junction with Wells Terrace

2010: Outside No 53

2012: Junction with Hanley Road/ Crouch Hill 2012: Between Morris Place and Lennox Road
