**Re: Freedom of Information request (Fol)–  
Lendal Bridge/Coppergate correspondence**

I would refer to your enquiry under the Freedom of Information Act received on 26<sup>th</sup> August 2014 in which referred to a Fol made by the York Press newspaper in February 2014.

You asked us to provide the following:

1. Copies of all the council's emails and all of any other documents provided to The York Press in response to that Freedom of Information Request.

I enclose copies of the emails sent to the Press in February in response to their Freedom of Information requests.

2. Copies of all subsequent emails and other correspondence to date within, from, and to Council members and officers that make reference to considerations of refunding penalty charges imposed for alleged contraventions of the Lendal Bridge traffic scheme and contraventions of the Coppergate traffic scheme.

To locate all emails and other correspondence to date within, from and to council members and officers would take more than 18 hours as we would have to search all staff members inboxes and filter through all emails and other documentation.

As such it is exempt under Section 12 of the Freedom of Information Act (2000). In order for us to assist you in finding the information you would like, please could you specify search terms such as 'Lendal Bridge', set a date range such as from 1<sup>st</sup> March to 1<sup>st</sup> April 2104 and identify key posts, team, or staff members who would be most likely to have the correspondence you are looking for.

If you are dissatisfied with our response you have the right to ask for a review of how your enquiry was handled and responded to. This can be done by contacting us through [foi@york.gov.uk](mailto:foi@york.gov.uk) stating your reason(s) why you are dissatisfied, and we will pass this to the information governance team who deal with all reviews of how we have dealt with FOI enquiries. If after they complete their investigation and reply to you with their findings, you still remain dissatisfied you can contact the Information Commissioner, contact details are:
