THE WANDSWORTH (PRESCRIBED ROUTES) (NO. 1) TRAFFIC ORDER 2008

Made: 12th February 2008

Coming into operation: 18th February 2008

The Council of the London Borough of Wandsworth, after consulting the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 6 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), as amended by section 8 of and Part I of Schedule 5 to the Local Government Act 1985(b) and the Road Traffic Act 1991(c), and of all other powers thereunto enabling hereby makes the following Order: -

- 1. This Order shall come into operation on 18th February 2008 and may be cited as the Wandsworth (Prescribed Routes) (No. 1) Traffic Order 2008.
- 2. In this Order-
 - "enactment" means any enactment, whether public general or local, and includes any order, byelaw, rule, regulation, scheme or other instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment and any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment.
- 3. No person shall cause any vehicle to proceed in any of the following roads or length of roads in the London Borough of Wandsworth in a direction other than that specified in respect of each road-
 - (a) Bemish Road from its junction with Lower Richmond Road towards its junction with Felsham Road;
 - (b) Chelverton Road from its junction with Charlwood Road towards a point opposite the party wall of No.11 and 13 Chelverton Road;
 - (c) Disraeli Road from its junction with Oxford Road towards its junction with Putney High Street;

- (d) Montserrat Road from its junction with Putney High Street to its junction with Oxford Road;
- (e) Norroy Road from its junction with Putney High Street to its junction with Charlwood Road;
- (f) Werter Road from its junction with Oxford Road to its junction with Putney High Street.
- 4. No person shall cause any vehicle proceeding in Felsham Road to enter or proceed in Bemish Road.
- 5. No person shall cause any vehicle proceeding in Oxford Road to enter or proceed in Montserrat Road.
- No person shall cause any vehicle proceeding in Charlwood Road to enter or proceed in Norroy Road.
- 7. No person shall cause any vehicle proceeding in Putney High Street to enter or proceed in Werter Road.
- 8. No person shall cause any vehicle proceeding in Putney High Street to turn right into Putney Bridge Road.
- 9. No person shall cause any vehicle proceeding in Putney High Street to turn right into Montserrat Road between the hours of 7 a.m. and 7 p.m. on Monday to Fridays inclusive.
- 10. No person shall cause any vehicle proceeding in Disraeli Road to turn left into Putney High Street.
- 11. No person shall cause any vehicle proceeding in Putney Bridge Road to turn left into Putney High Street.
- 12. Nothing in this Order shall apply in relation to -
 - (a) any vehicle being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes;
 - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform; or
 - (c) any person who causes any motor vehicle to proceed in accordance with any restriction or requirement indicated by traffic signs placed pursuant to section 66 or 67 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
- 13. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order the Wandsworth (Prescribed Route) Traffic Order 1971(d) is hereby revoked.
