Further to your enquiry of 14 November, I am now in a position to respond. Please accept my apologies for the slight delay in issuing this response.

Lancashire County Council does not have a specific policy for male victims of domestic abuse. However, all policies and contracts are written from a gender-neutral perspective. For example, the current medium and high risk victims contract supports all clients based on their risk level, not their gender. Therefore, male victims will receive the same level of support from this service as female victims. Specialist training from the Dyn Project was delivered to these specialist providers on working with male clients. Whilst refuges are not available for male victims, they are supported through this contract in partnership with local housing associations/councils to access housing support.
