There were teething problems re Code G, refusing arrests for caution plus 3 process. These seem to have settled done with guidance issued, although we have recieved a number of complaints from solicitors asking now why we are arresting and not using code G. We now have our Ch Insp meet Met Det Ch insp regularly to discuss any issues arising.
