Freedom of Information Request Reference FOI 1077254

I refer to your request dated 6 March 2017 to the Department of Health (DH), which was a follow-up to your previous requests of 20 August 2016 (our ref: FOI 1047275) and 2 October 2016 (our ref: FOI 1053054). As a result of new information which we contacted you about on 27 March 2017, you agreed that your request would revert back to your first request of 20 August 2016 (FOI 1047275) which read as follows:

“Please provide a copy of the complete Cameron Report into Hammersmith Hospital's Imaging Department June 2000.”

Your request has been handled under the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA).

I can confirm that DH holds the information you requested. However, we are withholding this information under sections 40 (1), 40 (2) and 41 of the FOI Act.

Under section 41 of the Act, a public authority is not obliged to disclose information provided in confidence. Section 40(2) provides for the protection of personal information which would not otherwise be available in the public domain, as disclosing this information would contravene data protection principles. Section 40(1) provides for the protection of data of which the applicant is the data subject.

If you are not satisfied with the handling of your request, you have the right to appeal by asking for an internal review. This should be submitted within two months of the date of receipt of the response to your original letter and should be addressed to the address at the top of this letter, or the email address at the end of this letter.

Please remember to quote the reference number above in any future communications.

If you are not content with the outcome of your internal review, you may complain directly to the Information Commissioner (ICO) who may decide to investigate your concerns. Generally, the ICO cannot make a decision unless you have already appealed our original response, and received our internal review response. The ICO will not usually investigate concerns where there has been an undue delay in bringing it to their attention. You should raise your concerns with them within three months of your last meaningful contact with us.
