Dear Mr Lennor,

Your request was received on 14 March 2017 and I am dealing with it under the terms of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 ('the Act').

You asked:

- Please could you provide the following information per college for entry in 2017 or 2018:*
- 1. Total number of applicants, number offered interviews and number receiving offers*
 - 2. Total number of applicants offering A levels as their highest qualification, number offered interviews and number receiving offers*
 - 3. Total number of domestic applicants, number offered interviews and number receiving offers*
 - 4. The breakdown of subjects offered by each applicant and grade achieved for each subject, number offered interviews and number receiving offers*
 - 5. Total number of students with History to AS level only that apply, number that receive interviews, and number that receive offers.*
 - [There was no question 6]*
 - 7. Total number of gap year students with Russian A level that apply, number that receive interviews, and number that receive offers.*
 - 8. Total number of gap year students with only 1 language A level or less that apply, number that receive interviews, and number that receive offers*

The information you have requested, while held by the University, is refused under section 12(1) of the Act. For the purpose of this application of section 12, the University has aggregated this request (received on 14 March 2017) with your previous requests (received on 13 January, 14 January and 20 February 2017; our references FOI-2017-19, 22 and 106) as permitted under Regulation 5 of the Fees Regulations so that the estimated cost of complying with this request is taken to be the total costs of complying with all of them. Your requests were received within a period of sixty consecutive working days and are requests that relate, to any extent, to the same or similar information. The University has
