As a condition of this consent, you are required to notify this office, at the earliest opportunity, of the commencement of any of the following activities covered by this consent: Spud, Re-spud, Mechanical and Geological Sidetrack, and on the completion of any of the following activities, covered by this consent: Well Completion, Well Re-completion, Well Testing, Well Abandonment, Short-Term Suspension and Long-Term Suspension. You will be advised if the activity results in a change in well number.

It is also a condition of this consent that a separate application is required for any activity not specifically covered by this consent. This includes any hydraulic fracturing operation, for which the approval of a Hydraulic Fracture Plan and a Hydraulic Fracture Consent will be required. Any Hydraulic Fracture operations that subsequently take place as part of this separately consented activity must conform to the approved plan. Any variation to the approved plan MUST be discussed with the Oil and Gas Authority beforehand.

This consent will expire on 14th December 2018.
