**Freedom of Information Act 2000**

We are writing in respect of your recent application for the release of information held by the Authority.

**You asked:**

“As owners of 3 S Fire, you are required under FOI to respond.

Following reports in the media regarding the high rise blocks of flats named Empire View and Gantry Court, Southampton, the following request for information is made to 3S Fire under the Regulatory Reform (Fire Safety) Order 2005 (FOI).

1. Has 3S Fire Ltd ever been required to undertake a Fire Risk Assessment on either of the blocks of flats named Empire View or Gantry Court, Southampton?
2. If the answer to Question 1 above is yes, what was the date when the last Fire Risk Assessment on either block of flats?
3. If the answers to Question 1 above is yes, did the Fire Risk Assessment for either block of flats identify the external wall cladding system as a fire risk?”

**Our answer:**

Hampshire Fire and Rescue Service (HFRS) does not own 3SFire. 3SFire are their own entity and separate organisation. HFRS therefore does not have access to or hold 3SFire data as per Section 1 Freedom Information Act (2000).
