We value our Stakeholder relationship in ensuring we liaise regularly with Local Planning Authorities to ensure you have the most up-to-date information about where our National Grid Assets are within your area of responsibility.

National Grid own and operate the Gas Transmission Network operating above 7 bar in Great Britain and the Electricity Transmission Network operating between 132kv and 400kv Network in England and Wales.

The consultation process with National Grid is very important to ensure:

1. That National Grid Transmission pipeline(s) integrity is protected and that National Grid's legal pipeline Easement strips are not infringed
2. Raise awareness of potential safety implications with a particular development, so they can be taken into account during the initial planning stages

National Grid's requirement for Gas and Electricity Transmission is to be consulted for any developments falling within the HSE outer zone. Any affected application should be directed to our Plant Protection team (address below).
