**Our Response:**

Information where less than 10 households have been placed in accommodation has been withheld pursuant to section 40 of the Freedom of Information Act. While this information by itself is not personal data we consider that, along with other information that may be available to you, it may be possible to identify a named individual from these figures. Section 40 is an absolute exemption and doesn't require consideration of the public interest test.


