Thank you for your email of 31st May 2017. You requested the following information:

"Please provide any information you possess about a signalling mechanism called "ATSC-DA: Automatic Tailback Signal Check-Delays Avoidance". Please also provide a list of locations, if any, where it is installed on the East Coast Main Line between King's Cross and Doncaster.

Note: I am not requesting a list of locations on any other line, nor am I requesting detailed wiring diagrams or scheme plans for the ECML locations."

I have reviewed your request, but to help me meet your request, I would be grateful if you could provide further details. Please can you clarify your meaning of ATSC-DA: Automatic Tailback Signal Check-Delays Avoidance"? For example:

- are you seeking information about 'conditional double red controls'?
