Dear Kevin Bridges,

I refer to your request, where you asked:

I would like to ask for details of any cost analysis that has been done to compare the cost of giving EU nationals living in the UK prior to the UK leaving the EU citizenship. As compared to the other options of registering them after the UK leaves the EU or giving them any other of the possible statuses that would need to be given to them.

I can confirm that this information is not held by the Department for Exiting the EU (DExEU). Whilst DExEU is responsible for overseeing and coordinating work on the UK's approach to the negotiations, as far as individual policy issues are concerned, other Government departments continue to lead on their respective portfolios.
