Freedom of Information Request

Thank you for your request for information.

Your request has been processed in accordance with Freedom of Information (Scotland) Act 2002.

The response is as follows –

Scottish Fire and Rescue Service (SFRS) does not hold the requested information in the manner requested. SFRS have in-house Fleet team who repair our vehicles. I have discussed this request with various departments and we do not record repairs as vandalism therefore section 17(1)(b) of Scotland Act 2002 notice that information not held is applicable.

In line with the terms of the Freedom of Information (Scotland) Act 2002, Scottish Fire and Rescue Service has in place a procedure by which a review of the way in which we handle requests for information can be carried out. If you are dissatisfied by the way Scottish Fire and Rescue Service have dealt with your request or about any decision made by them in connection with your request, and wish a review to be carried out, please inform me of this by 6 March 2018. In doing so, it would be helpful if you could state the matter, which has given rise to your dissatisfaction. Staff not involved in the original decision will handle any review.

Should you not be satisfied with the outcome of our review, you will then have the right to appeal to the Scottish Information Commissioner within 6 months. The Commissioner will decide whether your request has been dealt with properly, in accordance with the Act.
