Thank you for your email and attachments below.

I note that the report is dated June 2014 and makes reference to works in progress, and what is proposed at the replacement playing fields sites with anticipated timescales of when works will be completed.

Given that the report is over two years old, please would you be able to obtain an update from the applicant on what, to date, has actually been developed and made available for use at the replacement sites and what still remains undeveloped (if this is the case).

The Football Association have requested sight of the community use agreements for replacement sites mentioned in the report. Please could you obtain copies of these if they are available?

In planning applications such as this, Sport England usually relies on a Grampian style condition to link the site that is proposed to be redeveloped with replacement. However, it is very likely that there has been significant progression with the development of the replacement sites that this will not be necessary. Sport England, as part of this planning submission, needs this update in order to be confident that such a condition would not be required.

Please can this information be sent to the Local Planning Authority and not Sport England directly, so that it forms part of the planning application, and that you forward this on to me.
