

**THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF CALDERDALE**  
**(TRAFFIC REGULATION) (NO. 5) ORDER 2007**

The Borough Council of Calderdale in exercise of its powers under Sections 1 and 2 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, (hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby make the following Order:-

**PART ONE**

**ONE-WAY STREET**

1. Save as provided in Article 1 to this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a traffic warden cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in the length of road specified in Column 1 of the Schedule to this Order in a direction other than that specified in relation to that length of road in Column 2 of the said Schedule
  
2. Nothing in Article 1 of this Order shall apply to the driving of any mechanical road cleaning vehicle when used for that purpose between the hours of 11.30 pm and 7.00 am

## PART TWO

### PROHIBITION OF DRIVING

3. Save as provided in Article 3 of this Order no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a traffic warden cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in the length of road specified in the Second Schedule to this Order.
  
4. Nothing in Article 3 of this Order shall prohibit any person from causing or permitting a vehicle to proceed in the length of road specified in the said Schedule if the vehicle:-
  - (a) is being used for police, ambulance, fire brigade, local authority or water authority purposes when used in pursuance of statutory powers or duties:
  
  - (b) is being used, and cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the length of road so specified or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or near the said length of road of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunications apparatus as defined in the Telecommunications Act 1984;

- (c) requires access to or egress from any premises situated on or adjacent to the said length of road (where no suitable alternative means of access or egress is available) or any other premises accessible from and only from the said length of road;
- (d) is in actual use in connection with the removal of furniture to or from premises fronting, adjoining, abutting or situated off the said length of road where the vehicle cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road
- (e) requires access to or egress from the premises known as Christ Church situated at the junction of Leeds Road and Brighouse Road.

### **PART THREE**

#### **REVOCATION OF EXISTING ORDERS**


5. The Order or Orders specified in Column 1 of the Third Schedule to this Order are hereby revoked to the extent specified in relation thereto in Column 2 of the said Schedule

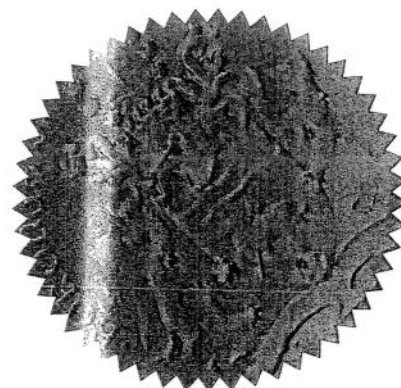
**PART FOUR**

**GENERAL**

6. The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restrictions or requirements imposed by any Regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act of 1984 or by or under any other enactment.
7. For the avoidance of doubt any reference in this Order to a length of road shall be deemed to be a reference to more than one length of road where the context requires it.
8. This Order shall come into operation on the 17<sup>th</sup> February 2008 and may be cited as "The Borough Council of Calderdale (Traffic Regulation) (No 5) Order 2007".

George Street, Hipperholme	From its junction with Brookeville Avenue to its junction with Wakefield Road in a south to north one way direction

**SCHEDULE 2**

**PROHIBITION OF DRIVING**

<b><u>Column 1</u></b>	<b><u>Column 2</u></b>
Brookeville Avenue, Hipperholme	From its junction with Brighthouse Road to its junction with George Street
George Street, Hipperholme	From its junction with Wakefield Road for its entire length of approximately 90m in a southerly direction.
