This information is published at <https://www.undergraduate.study.cam.ac.uk/apply/statistics> (the tables "Applications, Offers & Acceptances by UCAS Apply Centre" refer) and so is exempt under section 21(1) of the Act, which confers absolute exemption.

If you are unhappy with the service you have received in relation to your request and wish to make a complaint or request an internal review of this decision, you should contact us quoting the reference number above. The University would normally expect to receive your request for an internal review within 40 working days of the date of this letter and reserves the right not to review a decision where there has been undue delay in raising a complaint. If you are not content with the outcome of your review, you may apply directly to the Information Commissioner for a decision. Generally, the Information Commissioner cannot make a decision unless you have exhausted the complaints procedure provided by the University.
