Thank you for your email of 8 July in which you requested the following information:

Reference FOI FOI2019/04619 made by RN Stebbings i was following this with interest then referencing F012018/05062 & F012019/04619 i noticed that you have refused the request due to *identifacation* issues

i would like to pose the same question so i might get the answer

you appear to have merged the questions so the *anwser* is confusing

can you confirm that the following is correct.

a, fewer than 5 in lincs ACF, but larger than zero

b, fewer than 5 in notts ACF, but larger than zero

could you additional also provide the results for the last 5 years in lincs.

I am treating your correspondence as a request for information under the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) 2000.

A search for the information has now been completed within the Ministry of Defence, and I can confirm that the information in scope of your request is held and is attached.

I can confirm that the information provided to R Stebbings under FOI2019/04619 is correct.

With regards to your question about the last five years at Lincolnshire Army Cadet Force I can confirm that there were fewer than 5 but larger than zero officers with a criminal conviction or caution.
