Dear Mr Delahunty,

Thank you for your email of 26 July 2019 in which you request the following information:

“Dear Ministry of Defence, can you provide the number of Bangladeshi Armed Forces personnel that have been trained on Joint Defence Command Staff Courses for every year of the last ten years? Can you provide the total cost to the academy for their training each year also?”

I am treating your correspondence as a request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA). I am writing to confirm that the MOD holds information on the subject you have requested. Please note that these figures have been provided by International Defence Training (Army), which does not constitute official statistics produced by Defence Statistics. I should also explain that the Joint Services Command and Staff College at the Defence Academy of the UK has two courses which have been attended by Bangladeshi Armed Forces – the Advanced Command and Staff Course (ACSC) and the Overseas Directing Staff Course (ODSC).

In order to protect personal information governed by the Data Protection Act 2018, Section 40(2) ‘Personal Information’ of the FOIA has been applied to parts of it (see ~). The reason for this is because there are a low number of records within scope of your request and releasing this information could potentially enable identification of individuals, either now or in the future, when it might be combined with other information. Section 40 is an absolute exemption and there is therefore no requirement to consider the public interest in making a decision to withhold the information.

With regards to cost, I can confirm that there is no cost to the Defence Academy for their training. All international places at JSCSC are either funded by the countries themselves or by the UK Ministry of Defence.

Please note that the Information Commissioner will not normally investigate your case until the MOD internal review process has been completed.
