**Freedom of Information Request 4116854**

*This matter is linked to several your council members and it needs to be investigated if you are not willing to address this matter please state the reasons why and this will go to the outside bodies..”*

**RESPONSE:**

Liverpool City Council would advise that it is not a matter for the City Council to establish a Public Inquiry nor do we have powers to do so. Under the provisions of the Inquiries Act 2005 it is a matter for central Government to make such determinations and undertake the associated actions.

This concludes our response.

The City Council will consider appeals, referrals or complaints in respect of your request under the Freedom of Information Act 2000. However, these must be submitted in writing to [Informationrequests@liverpool.gov.uk](mailto:Informationrequests@liverpool.gov.uk) within 28 days of receiving your response.

The matter will be dealt with by an officer who was not previously involved with the response and we will look to provide a response within 28 working days.

If you remain dissatisfied you may also apply to the Information Commissioner for a decision about whether the request for information has been dealt with in accordance with the Freedom of Information Act 2000.
