Re: Freedom of Information request INF 2006051

Thank you for your request for information, received by North Lincolnshire Council 20th June 2020 requesting information about discharge of planning conditions for Wressle oil development. I have considered your request in detail and can confirm that the council holds the following information:

- I should be grateful if you would let me know which planning conditions for the Wressle oil production development have been discharged and which remain to be approved before site work can begin.

The submitted request did not include the application reference on which you required us to provide a response. However, details are being provided pertaining to PA/2018/1316 which was allowed at appeal on the 17th January 2020.

I can confirm that condition 15 attached to PA/2018/1316 was discharged by the local planning authority on the 29th April 2020.

Details have been submitted and are awaiting consideration for the discharge of conditions 4, 16 and 17 attached to PA/2018/1316.

There will also be a requirement for condition 5 to be discharged to the satisfaction of the local planning authority before any works can be commenced.
