Thank you for your request of 10 February 2021 under the Freedom of Information (Scotland) Act 2002 (FOISA).

Your request

You asked:

"The NRS website states that "Of the total number of deaths registered in week 5 (01 February to 07 February), there were 374 where COVID-19 was mentioned on the death certificate. This is a decrease of 70 deaths on the previous week".
What are the mean, median and mode ages of death involving COVID-19 that have been recorded for Week 5: 01 February - 07 February (n = 374)?"
