

2011 Census Hard Edit Rules for Relationships and Sex

Edit Rule	DLT Name
A person cannot have more than one Husband or Wife/Civil Partner.	BP1: only one spouse
A person cannot have a Husband or Wife/Same-sex Civil Partner/Partner plus a Partner.	BP2: spouse no partner
A person cannot have a Husband or Wife/Same-sex Civil Partner/Partner plus a Partner.	BP2a: spouse no partner
A person cannot have a Husband or Wife/Same-sex Civil Partner/Partner plus a Partner.	BP2a: spouse no partner
Two people with at least one parent in common cannot be married to or in a same-sex civil partnership with/partners of each other.	BP3: siblings not spouse
If two people are married, both cannot be of the same sex.	BP4: opp sex spouse
If two people are in a same-sex civil partnership, both must be of the same sex.	BP5: same sex cp
A person aged less than 16 years cannot be a same-sex civil partner.	BP6: no cp if <16
A person with a same-sex civil partner in the household cannot have a marital status other than in a registered same-sex civil partnership or separated, but still legally in a same-sex civil partnership.	BP14: cp if cp in house
