### Freedom of Information Request

Thank you for your email of 26<sup>th</sup> May requesting admissions statistics for the University's BN (Hons) Nursing Studies programme.

You requested the total number of applicants, number of applicants interviewed, and number of offers made in the 2019/20 admissions cycle. This information is provided in the table below.

Applications	723
Invited to Interview	227
Offers Made	155

Please note, the *invited to interview* figure provided here is based on the number of applications which were flagged to receive an interview by our admissions staff. In a very small number of cases an applicant may have withdrawn their application in the period between being selected for interview and an invite being sent. As such, the actual number of applicants who received an invite to attend an interview may be slightly lower than the number reported here.
