I refer to the above site and I understand that [REDACTED] has since left Turley, hence I have contacted you direct.

I note that within the Harthill application, the Planning Inspector's report was dated 7th June 2018 and condition 01 stated:

1) The development hereby permitted shall begin not later than three years from the date of this decision. The local planning authority shall be notified in writing of the date of commencement at least 7 days prior to that date.

I understand that no preparation works to take place on site, such as the creation of the site access, improvements to the passing places or foundations have been dug etc. We are therefore of the opinion that the application has now lapsed.
