### **Freedom of Information Request - RF120220464**

Thank you for your request to the BBC of 24 March 2022 seeking the following information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 ('the Act'):

*I would like to receive a copy of myself DANIELA PANI WITH ROBERT KILROY SILK in 1997.*

We are withholding this information under section 40(1) (personal information) of the FOI Act. Information is exempt by virtue of section 40 if it constitutes personal data of which the requestor is the data subject and disclosure would contravene any of the principles in the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR). Any disclosure made by virtue of the Freedom of Information Act is regarded as a public disclosure and not a disclosure to an individual. Disclosure of this information would breach the principle to only process personal data lawfully, fairly and in a transparent manner.

### **Appeal Rights**

A request for an internal review must be made within 40 working days of receiving the BBC's response to your original request.
