Appeals

If a licence holder is aggrieved by the decision of the West Midlands County Council in modifying conditions specified in a disposal licence he may appeal to the Secretary of State in accordance with Section 10 of the Control of Pollution Act 1974. Appeals must be notified within 6 months of the date of this notice to the Secretary, Department of the Environment Waste Disposal Division, Becket House, Lambeth Palace Road, London SEl. The Secretary of State has power to allow a longer period for the giving of notice of an appeal but he will not normally be prepared to exercise this power unless there are special circumstances which excuse the delay in giving notice of an appeal.
