We can confirm that the information requested is held by Brighton & Hove City Council. I have enclosed copies of the information that is being released to you.

Please provide me with all the A259 traffic data (itemised hourly counts per week) from ATC23 and ATC614 for 2018 and the data you so far have for 2019.

My preference is for the information to be delivered in XLS or CSV format to facilitate its use in studies to promote improvements to the A259, including joint studies with ESCC.

A complentary request to ESCC for ATC97 and ATC24 data has been issued.

Thank you for your FoI request (BHCC reference number 4089265) regarding traffic data on the A259. I sincerely apologise for the delay in responding to your request, but have now been advised of the following answer to your question(s) by Transport officers:-

Two XLS files are attached which include all available traffic data for counter sites 23 (A259 Marine Drive between Roedean Road & Greenways) and 614 (A259 Marine Drive, just west of Chailey Avenue) on the A259 between January 2018 and June 2019. Data are split into hourly counts by day and by week, and also weekly 5 day and 7 day averages.
