	Dartmouth Circus: suggested consideration of bus priority into the City Centre	
	<ul> <li>New Town Row/Summer Lane: Jacobs to check the committed BCR layout. PE requested a bus gate to allow blue light access, and raised that the existing pedestrian crossing runs on an 'all-red' arrangement which would need to be considered in design.</li> </ul>	
	Lucas Circus: Possible release of land for 50 homes was raised.	
	• Five Ways: This junction would be challenging and Jacobs was to further examine issues around local access and Sheepcote Street.
