In accordance with section 20(1) of the Freedom of Information (Scotland) Act 2002, I understand that you have requested an internal review of your original request relating to Common Purpose training, on the basis that Police Scotland had, thus far, failed to respond to your request.

My role is to consider the response issued and determine whether or not your request was handled in accordance with the provisions of the Freedom of Information (Scotland) Act 2002.

In terms of section 21(4)(c) of the Act, as Police Scotland failed to offer a response within 20 working days, I therefore conclude that your request has not been handled in accordance with the Freedom of Information (Scotland) Act 2002.
