Request for Information – ATISN 8167

I wrote to you on 4 February 2014 regarding your request for information. In your request you asked, what progress has been made to provide direct motorway access to the Rhoose area of Barry and what are the projected costs.

I confirm that we hold information relating to your request. However, I have concluded that some of this information is exempt from disclosure under section 21 of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA) – Information accessible to the applicant by other means. In addition to this statement, I can advise that studies are underway for improved road connections between the Culverhouse Cross interchange to the St Athan - Cardiff Airport Enterprise Zones. This includes improvement to the A4226 Five Mile Lane. The extent of proposals will be identified once the advisors have completed their initial work and the delivery of improvements, for example to Five Mile Lane, will be planned in collaboration with Vale of Glamorgan Council.
