Website code and design is reviewed whenever a website has a major revision. This is both a manual and automated process. We can provide reports regarding the automated process but would require you to narrow your request giving details of the specific websites you want information for.

Website content is reviewed whenever page content is updated. This is a manual, ongoing process.

As regards your question about accessibility, we are currently producing an accessibility statement for all our websites. These statements list what we are
